The trip will include a visit to two state-of-the-art treating plants; three large sawmills producing a variety of products from Southern yellow pine to hardwoods; and a trip to one of the nation's largest steel tie plate manufacturing plants.

For those planning to extend their stay, there are numerous attractions, including hot mineral baths and horse racing in Hot Springs; river rafting, canoeing and fishing on the Buffalo River; the Clinton Presidential Library and River Market area in Little Rock; and nearby Memphis, Tenn. §
